Dear Sponsors

In my personal ministry, one of the things I do along with my wife, is being in charge of a house church. The name of the church is Iglesia Casera. (Home Church) We're a small church, and we're not independent. We are part of IBSS (Iglesia Bautista de Santos Suarez in Havana). We replicate some things from the church. We teach the Bible and preach the Gospel.

Even though our house is small, we always have at least 20 in attendance. Some are members of the IBSS, but we also have some neighbors, and new believers from the community who visit. This church gives us the opportunity to disciple and reach people with the Gospel.

Our experience with the house church started around 30 years ago. One of the first times we had a service was at our neighbors home. She lived in the basement of our house. She used to practice Santeria. For many years she considered herself our enemy and tried to harm us. One day, around the end of the year (1992) she got terminally ill. She called my wife to talk to her. She repented for what she did for all those years, and accepted Christ into her temple. After that, we continued treating her like a Christian until she died and went with the Lord. That is just one story of our many experiences we have at our church.
