It is a pleasure to greet you. We are very happy to count on your prayers and your support. They are of great help and a blessing. In July we had a conference "I am Debtor". Every year it is a blessing to our church. Our church participated on Wednesday and Friday. We were very edified by the word of God. We also had the opportunity to share a worship service with pastor Miguel Murillo who was the guest pastor.

We were also distributing tracts elsewhere in Quilicura. We hope to cover a large part of the commune. Also the men of our church got together to share the word of God. We learned at that time the character of a mature man. We also had a moment of witness, and it is a blessing to hear how God is changing the lives of men in our church. I ask you to pray for each one of them. A Colombian couple Yesenia and Edison came to the church, the couple found us by our Facebook page. They have been able to continue to attend faithfully. They have two children. They have a great desire to continue attending and are already taking discipleship. Yesenia invited her sister and her husband to church. They were participating in the marriage meeting that I will talk about later. Klarine is another man of Colombian nationality who arrived at the church by a treaty. He has 5 meetings with us. It is always a great blessing to see how more people are coming to the knowledge of the truth. This month we had a marriage meeting. It is a very important activity as a church where marriages can be put together and we can share together the word of God. We had a guest pastor, Pastor Emanuel Perez. He is pastor of the Baptist church Sublime Gracia in Cerro-Navia. We also had fourteen married couples attend. We hope to continue to meet and hope that more marriages can be included in this ministry. As you know our church has a Haitian ministry where we have a special class for them. Many of those who congregate with us come from charismatic churches where the main gifts are the languages and the manifestations. The first cult of Haitians was a bit complicated for us but now things are working better with the help of two key brothers within the group of Haitians. We have also been greatly served by the discipleships we have had with them, where every Wednesday we teach them the importance of the word of God and that all things must be done in order and decently. During the past month, the children were offering money for the missionary of the month that was Wilber Hallasi. Each child wrote letters of encouragement to him and his family. They were reading their mission report each Thursday and praying for their prayer requests. They also recorded a video for him. They managed to raise money that we hope will be a blessing. The pastor and his family sent a video of thanks and encouragement so that the children continue to support missionaries around the world. In the next two months the children will be praying and offering for the pastor Luis Benitez, who has his work in Lima-Peru.
