I, along with my whole family, greatly thank you for being an instrument in God’s hands in supporting the work of our ministries. We are also so grateful for your spiritual support through your prayers. Please continue strengthening me through your prayers as we strive to fulfill the vision and mission which God has given our church and all the work yet to be done in Mayabeque. Apart from pastoring the churches in Jaruco and Caraballo, I am coordinating missionary work in the province of Mayabeque, and attempting to guide all of our missionaries to stay close to God as they serve Him in their respective fields. Twenty-two of the men serving have been trained in our Center for Missionary Training of Jaruco, where I serve as a director and professor of Practical Principles of Church Planting and Missionary Studies. I also teach New Testament Studies in one of our satellite seminars. This is all done while continuing to minister in our missions (Ayala and ICA 20 kilometers away) alongside another missionary. Although my time is short, I do not want to stop visiting the missions. It is my passion to obey my Lord and go to the distant fields for love of lost souls who must hear the message of our Lord Jesus. Our goal is to knock on every door in ICA in the month of February, and we would like to begin our mission’s trips to start new churches in the 188 neighborhoods where there are no church plants. I ask that you pray the Lord would provide a vehicle to travel between missions. Currently, we rely on public transportation to travel and depend on the good will of people for our next meal many times. Through all this, the Lord of the harvest has been faithful in his provision. Please continue praying for us.
