Dear Brethren, Thank you!!! Thank you so much for serving our God in the ministry He placed on your shoulders. Thank you for collaborating with us for the expansion of His kingdom, and helping complete the Great Commission. My family and I are grateful with God and you. The initiative you have to help, is a motivation to keep the faith, as we wait for the glorious return of our Lord Jesus Christ. It's awesome that even while going through cultures, governments, geographical limitations, the church continues strong with the collaboration of our talents that He provides. Since this is the first letter that I send, I consider it necessary to write a quick briefing of our ministry here in Cuba. If you can, find a map so you could pray for my family and work team. My wife was a professional singer and I was a music producer when in the year 2009 we responded to the calling of God. We were called to be missionaries (without having a livable income back then) to the City of Sanctispiritus where we used to live. Two years later we planted more than 15 small groups, each with a leader, and purpose for multiplication. In 2011, now as a worker for missions groups, and with three small children, we decided to sell our house. We bought a house in the municipality of Colombia, in the province of Las Tunas, in west Cuba. (Our kids are 1,6, and 7 years old at the moment.) We moved with the purpose of starting 60 house churches south of the province. 60 is a huge number, I know, but with God nothing is impossible. We started with one small group in a new house and today, as I write this letter, we already have four churches each with their own leader. Each leader has no less than three houses where he has started new groups. Just with those four churches, there are 140 brethren who meet and minister one to another. Every Sunday we meet all together to celebrate the greatness of our God. At this moment, my fundamental work is the preparation of the leadership. Their care, and that we work as a team. We ask that you pray for us. We have a worship choir started by my children, other teenagers, my wife and I. The things that God does with us, hahaha. This is the information on which I will continue to update you. May the peace of God govern your hearts.
