When we asked the people living near our sign board, they all said they didn't see who did it. Anyways, we still thanked the Lord that day that there were 9 people saved. The next day, we went again soul winning where 6 people saved. But when we went inside the church, one of our young men noticed that our bulletin board was vandalized. Someone carved some nude drawings on our cork boards. I felt really discouraged and hurt. As of now our church building is not yet finished and pretty much open. Anyways, we just patched it with some printed materials to conceal it. The next day, we went to the island to minister to the kids and preach the gospel. There were 108 kids on our extension class and 15 adults were saved. Going back, on the little boat, I whispered and asked God what will Satan do next. We were all wet because of the bigger waves. We went back home safely and glad. We then prepared the church for the service the next day because it was Saturday. We had a coconut fellowship with the young men that went with me to the island. Later that day, one of the young men called me and informed me that one of our teenage girls was chased with a bolo by her eldest brother intending to kill her. (He's mentally ill due to drugs.) She escaped the attack, but one of the neighbors didn't. He was killed instantly with a huge wound on his neck. The guy that was killed is also an uncle of one of our teenage boys.
