Greetings in Christ! It was a rough but exciting ride this month! We were bombarded with setbacks this month. From health issues to wayward Christians disheartening people in the ministry. But by God's grace we always look up to His faithfulness. Many times we feel alone, deserted and betrayed. God allows people to come our way. Some are good people, some are not so good ones. But we know God always has a plan. One morning, I was contemplating if there are things that I did or I did not do to some certain people in our ministry that would cause them to want us to fail. Every time people turn their back from God and from us it hurts so much. I was discouraged and wounded because I love these dear folks but it seems to them, all of the love and labor we did to them is of vain. I felt sorry for myself. But God told me, they are not the only ones who needed us here. There are 70 thousand people all over the place. I gathered myself and was ready to take on the day when I heard someone knocking and was looking for me. This man was a complete stranger. But he said he's a Christian from another island. He said he has a brother that lives near us that just died from cancer. He was so concerned about his loved ones' salvation. He then asked me if I can preached to the funeral service. I told him of course I can and I will. That night I preached to around 80 people there, where 21 people were counted accepted Christ as their Saviour, not including the teenagers. The 2nd and last night I preached to around 200 people, where many many raised their hands professed that they accepted Christ as their Saviour. I was alone that night and there was no way to count those people who accepted Christ for I was alone. But God knows who and how many were saved. But on my conservative calculation around 60 people raised their hands for salvation. And one of the young man who got saved that night is now coming to church for 3 consecutive Sundays now.
