This month I was invited to preach the missionary conference of the Bethlehem Baptist Church in the city of Danlí, I was very encouraged to see the commitment of them and their pastor in supporting missions, on the day we went out several times with my son and with the brothers to look for the souls, it was a tremendous blessing to see every night the temple full and the church very willing to continue obeying with a missionary heart. It has been very difficult to deal with my problem in the column these two months because in our country the weather is rainy and hot, I am experiencing more pain, I have a new appointment scheduled to see the neurosurgeon, please pray for the Lord's provision because no I have medical insurance so our support is affected by medical-hospital expenses. We made a Camp with the youth in Copan and we supported the missionary there having time for talks and preaching every day and activities with the church. Last week we celebrated Children's Bible Clubs in the three churches, almost 300 attended among parents, children and youth, we preached the word of God, people were saved, we also gave away pockets and school supplies. OUR CURRENT NEEDS: More souls saved and more believers obeying baptism. For our support and for more laborers for the harvest. For the missionary project of the construction of sanitary services in Toyos. for the church in San Juan Pueblo since we started saving for the purchase of the land and building a temple there since we are still renting a house in which we gather for prayer service, Sunday school and discipleship classes.
